The undersigned respectfully pray

I was driving east on Concord Ave. August 4, around 10:45 when my left front wheel struck a 2 ft. hole. My car went out of control and swerved to the right over the sidewalk. It hit six concrete posts before it spun clockwise and came to a stop. Through no fault of mine my car was totaled. I received several cuts on my left hand and some particulates in my eye. The next day I went to Santa Maria Hospital and they in turn sent me to Mass Eye and Ear for treatment. My car was towed to the Sunoco Station on Concord Ave. We have since had the car towed home and it is now in the driveway. The towing and service charges came to 35 dollars. Also I have taken snapshots of the car. We called the Allstate Insurance Company to find out the value of a 1966 Ford Fairlane. They said it was worth between 200-500 dollars depending on the condition. The car ran well and the body was in mint condition. I have a part time job in Newton lower falls and I need a car for transportation. The officer at the scene of the accident has filed a police report
