ORDERED: That the City Manager confer with the Assistant City Manager for Human Services to emphasize the importance of assuring that large senior buildings like Manning, J.F.K., Burns, Miller's River, 2 Mt. Auburn, 700 Huron, Truman, etc., be considered as route stops.
