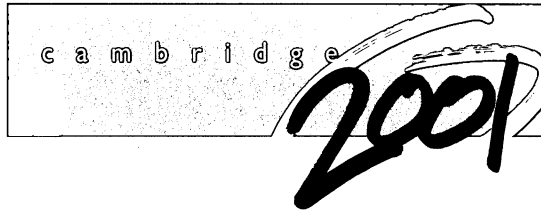

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$730,787.88 in Chapter 90 funds from the Massachusetts Highway Department to the Public Investment Fund Public Works Extraordinary Expenditures account to provide funds for improvements to several streets.

It should be noted that, of the \$730,787.88 to be appropriated, \$687,348.89 is the remainder of the current allocation and \$43,438.99 is the balance of previous allocations which has not yet been appropriated.
