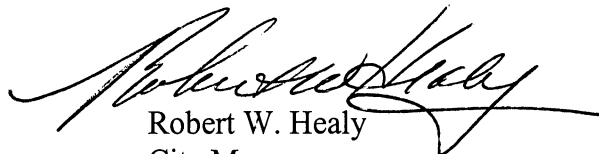

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$1,999,049 in the Grant Fund of the Community Development Department Salary and Wages Account (\$733,114), Other Ordinary Maintenance Account (\$1,260,285), and Travel and Training Account (\$5,650). Funds were received from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development and will be used to support the Lead-safe Cambridge Program for the two-year period of January 1, 2003 through December 31, 2004. Lead Safe Cambridge will make a significant contribution to the present efforts of the City to prevent lead poisoning, as well as create and maintain affordable lead-safe housing for very low and low-income families with young children.
