PETITION FOR LOCATION

Boston Edison Company
To the Metropolitan District Commission

Your petitioner, Boston Edison Company, a corporation duly established by law and lawfully engaged in the sale, transmission and distribution of electricity in certain cities and towns and elsewhere, respectfully represents that public convenience and necessity require locations in the Cities of Boston and Cambridge, namely John F. Gilmore Bridge, Boston (Charlestown District) and Cambridge, a distance of about 2,044 feet, pipes, conduits and cables, from Austin Street to Monsignor O'Brien Highway, Cambridge; Monsignor O'Brien Highway, Cambridge, a distance of about 220 feet, pipes, conduits and cables, from John F. Gilmore Bridge to Industrial Park Road, Cambridge; Industrial Park Road, Cambridge, a distance of about 75 feet, pipes, conduits and cables, from Monsignor O'Brien Highway to end of taking line, Cambridge; Charles River, Boston, a distance of about 350 feet, pipes, conduits and cables, in the river from General Service Administration Property, Cambridge/Boston, to the U.S. Pierhead and Bulkhead Line, Boston; Leverett Circle, Boston, a distance of about 425 feet, pipes, conduits and cables, to Charles Street, Boston; Charles Street, Boston, a distance of about 1,815 feet, pipes, conduits and cables, to Charles Circle, Boston (1-manhole); Charles Circle, Boston, a distance of about 550 feet, pipes, conduits and cables.

Pipes to be installed will be 2 - 8 5/8 inch with cables therein, in locations with the exception of the Charles River. In the Charles River there will be 4 - 8 5/8 inch pipes, 2 with cables therein to be used for the transmission of electricity and 2 spare pipes. Conduits to be installed will be 2 - 2 inch in size and contain fiber optic cables.

Plans showing the locations of the pipes and conduits to be constructed and maintained hereunder are filed and signed by F. J. Greenberg and dated March 9, 1987, No. S4704, sheets 21 through 26 of 48 sheets, and sheets 30 through 37 of 48 sheets.

On the 22nd day of July, 1987, the Department of Public Utilities in Case No. DPU 86-255 on the petition of your petitioner entered an order adjudging that the above described locations were required by public convenience and necessity.

Wherefore, your petitioner respectfully prays that your Commission may by order grant to your petitioner locations for said steel pipes and conduits with cables therein.
