- RESOLVED: That this City Council request the City Manager to direct the Traffic and Parking Department to waive the resident parking requirements on Monday Evening, December 24th and during the morning hours of December 25th. This in order to prevent the impediment of any vehicle of arctic registration operated by real or imagined personnel, from completing appointed rounds due to the cities parking ordinance; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That City release the aforementioned visitor and the members of any accompanying entourage from appearing before the Interim Parking Control Committee if said visitor finds it necessary to utilize a parking space not legally recognized by the City of Cambridge.
