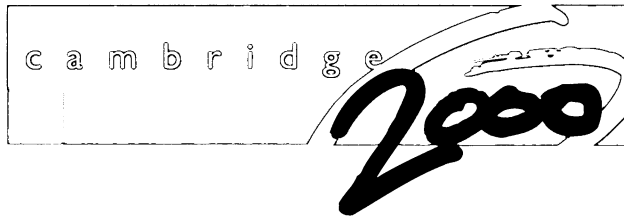

I am hereby requesting an appropriation of \$650,000.00 in the Public Investment Fund of the Fire Department Extraordinary Expenditures Account from property taxes.
