WHEREAS: For a number of years there has been a serious parking problem in East Cambridge generated by the new Court House facility, and

WHEREAS: It is not only the obligation of Middlesex County to provide parking for the users of the Court House facility, but also, the duty of the City of Cambridge to assist in the county's efforts, now therefore be it

ORDERED: That a meeting attended by a representative of the County Commissioner's Office, the City Manager, the City Solicitor, the Traffic Commissioner, a representative of the Redevelopment Authority, and other appropriate city officials, be called to discuss a resolution to the serious traffic and parking problem in the East Cambridge - Court House area.
