To the Honorable, the Mayor and Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge.

The undersigned respectfully pray that the order to remove the fence upon the land of Watson Hein at the corner of Spring and 3^d Street East Cambridge may be so far modified, that the fence may remain for the time being, in its present place, the land being in the Market for Sale, and the fence being built of very substantial branch post, would involve considerable expense, and as improvements (by building) may very soon be made, we respectfully submit that it would be a severe tax upon the ^{widow's} owner, which would profit ^{her} them nothing -
