- WHEREAS: On August 9, 1956 over 20,000 women of all races demonstrated in Pretoria, South Africa in defiance of the pass system; and
- WHEREAS: For over 30 years hundreds of thousands of people have been detained, arrested, exiled and killed for speaking against apartheid and in favor of basic democratic rights for all South Africans; and
- WHEREAS: The South Africans Women's Day Coalition will hold a day long celebration on August 9th at the Blackstone Community School in Boston in commemoration of South African Women's struggle and contribution to eliminate apartheid; therefore, be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council encourage people to participate in South African Women's Day celebration and extend our support and congratulations to all those people committed to end apartheid and guarantee basic democratic rights for all South Africans.
