Communications Gateway Network, Inc. ("Company"), a Delaware corporation has applied to the Department of Public Utilities to provide resold telecommunications services within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts. The Company proposes to offer a variety of telecommunications services, including 1 + direct dialed long distance services (MTS), wats access lines (WAL), dedicated access lines (DAL), 800 services and calling card services.

Application of Communications Gateway Network, Inc., under the provisions of Chapter 159 of the General Laws as amended, for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to operate as a resale, value-added or interexchange common carrier within the Commonwealth of Massachusetts.

Comments, objections and requests for a public hearing on the proposed service must be made in writing with specific reasons for requesting a public hearing, and filed with the Secretary of the Department on or before December 14, 1992.

The petitioner, Communications Gateway Network, Inc., is required to give notice by publications hereof once, in the Boston Globe, the Morning Union (Springfield), the Berkshire Eagle (Pittsfield) and the Worcester Telegram, and to serve a copy hereof at least twenty-one (21) days prior to said date [December 21, 1992], on the attached list, and to make return of service and publication no later than December 21, 1992.
