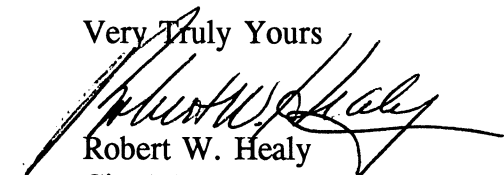

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting the appropriation of \$8,500.00 into the General Fund of the Department of Human Services Salary and Wages Account from Property Taxes. The ESL network, a new initiative in FY94, was previously funded with two grants to the Friends of the Community Learning Center, Inc: \$15,000 from The Boston Foundation and \$2,000 from the Cambridge Community Foundation. The City Of Cambridge provided matching funds of \$26,330. For FY95, the Foundations have awarded \$7,500 and \$1,000 respectively leaving the project with an \$8,500 shortfall. This appropriation will restore the project to full funding.
