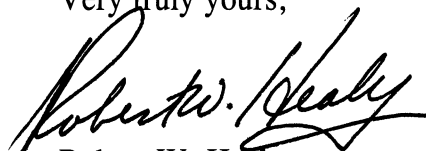
To The Honorable, The City Council:

In response to Awaiting Report Item No. 7, regarding a report on increasing the lighting at the intersection of Irving, Scott and Farrar Streets, City Electrician George Fernandes reports the following:

Due to the large area of this intersection, lighting will be increased and is scheduled to be completed by February 27th. The light presently attached to the pole at the center of the intersection will be relocated on the existing pole and an additional light fixture will be added, resulting in an increase in lighting and an improved pattern of light.

In response to the communication received with this Council Order, street lights remain on from dusk to dawn each night and are not turned off intentionally. The light in question malfunctioned and has since been repaired.
