WHEREAS: The City of Cambridge is greatly concerned about the problem of youth violence and the tragic effects it has on youth, families, and communities; and

WHEREAS: We must always seek solutions to this tragic crisis; and

WHEREAS: A broad based coalition of seventy national educational, religious, local government, law enforcement, medical, legal, civil rights, media, community service, and family organizations have announced a week long campaign against youth violence beginning April 25, 1994 and ending May 1, 1994; and

WHEREAS: The organizers hope that activities planned during this week will seek solutions to the problem of youth violence as well as publicizing the problem; and

WHEREAS: The centerpiece of the campaign will be a one-hour television special, "Kids Killing Kids" which will be broadcast simultaneously on CBS and FOX on Tuesday, April 26, 1994; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That this Cambridge City Council does hereby declare the week beginning April 25, 1994 and ending May 1, 1994 to be "Let's Stop Kids Killing Kids" week in the City of Cambridge; and be it further

RESOLVED: That all Cambridge residents are encouraged to watch the television broadcast "Kids Killing Kids," and to further participate in any and all activities being planned as part of the week.
