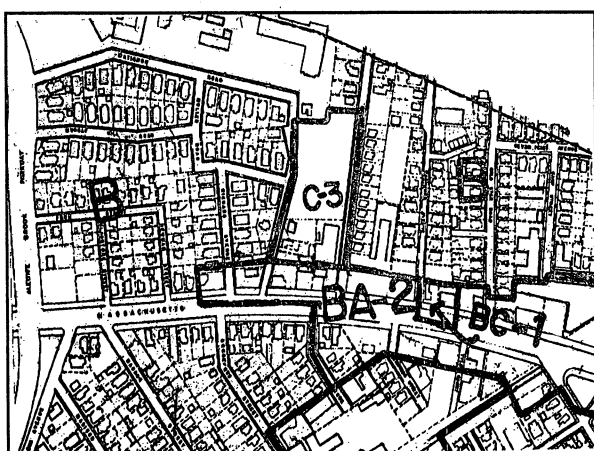
NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

The Planning Board of the City of Cambridge will hold a public hearing on Tuesday, May 19, 1998 at 9:00 p.m., in the Conference Room, third floor, City Hall Annex, 57 Inman Street, Cambridge, Massachusetts on a petition from the City Council to amend the Zoning Map of the City of Cambridge by rezoning from Business C-1 to Business A-2 an area of land as shown on the accompanying map. The Floor Area Ratio would change from 3.0 to 1.75 (of which 1.0 can be nonresidential), the height would decrease from 50 feet to 45 feet, and the amount of lot area required for each dwelling unit would increase from 450 square feet to 600 square feet.
