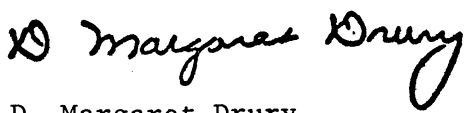

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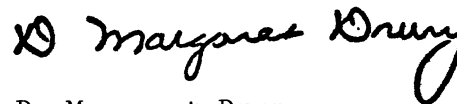

I am hereby requesting a transfer of \$3,000 in the General Fund from the Reserve Account Other Ordinary Maintenance Account to the Women's Commission Other Ordinary Maintenance Account.
