- WHEREAS: Arthur G. MacKenzie was born in Cambridge, graduated from Harvard University in 1918 and later served in World War I as an air service pilot; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur was extremely active in many civic groups including the Rotary Club where he was a past President, a member of the Salvation Army Advisory Board and the Chamber of Commerce; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur MacKenzie was also a dedicated public servant in addition to serving as City Treasurer from 1942 to 1944 he also served as a member of the Cambridge City Hospital Board of Trustees; and
- WHEREAS: Arthur MacKenzie was a member of the Aleppo Shrine for 62 years, an association of which he was proud; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending our deepest sympathy to the family of Arthur G. MacKenzie at this time of their personal loss; and be it further
