In Board of Aldermen, *Apr 24* 188*8*.

Ordered,

That the Committee on Roads and Bridges be authorized to cause such repairs to be made upon the steps of the Soldiers Monument, as may be found necessary. The cost thereof not to exceed the sum of ^{\$}275.⁰⁰, unless it shall be found on examination that the foundation of the monument is defective or has become unsettled, in which case the facts shall be reported to the City Council for further instructions in the matter of such repairs.

The expense here inbefore authorized, to be charged to the appropriation for Shade Trees and Public Grounds.
