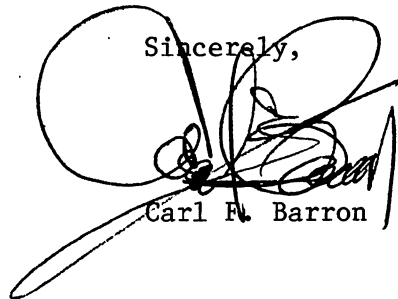
RE: Security and Safety in Central Square
