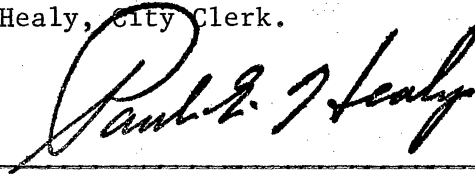
MAYOR RUSSELL

- WHEREAS: It has become increasingly apparent that a severe lack of parking around City Hall, particularly for City employees, exists; and
- WHEREAS: Certain employees are required to use their motor vehicles in the performance of their official duties and upon returning to City Hall, often find that their prudent efforts to obtain a legal parking space at a meter is only foiled by their inability to either constantly move the car or put money into the meter, consequently resulting in their receiving numerous parking tickets; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to instruct the Director of Traffic and Parking to establish and implement an official windshield identification card or sticker for all eligible City employees who require the use of their personal motor vehicle during any part of their official duties, so that these vehicles would be recognized as such by members of the Police and Traffic Departments.
