Oct. 10, 1860.

ORDERED, That the Clerk be directed to notify the abutters on Harvard Street, between Elm Street and the Causeway, so called, on Main Street, to remove all fences or other encroachments upon said Harvard Street to the line of said Street, as delineated on a Plan of the same on file in the office of the City Clerk, within ten days from the date of this order.

ORDERED, That if such encroachments are not removed by the abutters, within the ten days above specified, the Superintendent of Streets be directed to remove the same, at the expense of the parties maintaining such encroachments.

Sept. 21. 1859. "The Petition of Samuel Palmer for the determination of the line of Howard Street, near Windsor Street, was referred to the Superintendent of Streets, with instructions to point out the line of said street as laid down on the Plan of the same on file in the office of the City Clerk."

Sept. 30. 1859. "The Superintendent of Streets reported that he had pointed out to Mr. Samuel Palmer the lines of Howard Street, near Windsor Street, and, by permission of the Board, Mr. Palmer was heard in relation to the same: when it was

Ordered, That the Board meet at the corner of Howard and Windsor Streets, on Saturday, October 1st, at 3 o'clock P.M., to consider and determine the lines of Howard Street."

Oct. 1. 1859. "The Mayor and Aldermen met, pursuant to assignment, at 3 o'clock P.M., at the corner of Howard and Windsor Streets, to consider and determine as to the lines of Howard Street."

Present, the Mayor and Aldermen Burges, Chapman, and Dickinson, but no groom."

Oct. 5. 1859. "The subject of the lines of Howard Street was taken up and considered; and it was Ordered, That notice

be given to the abutments on Harvard Street, between Elm Street and the Eastern end of said Harvard Street, at ~~the~~ its junction with Main Street, to remove all their encroachments upon said Harvard Street, before the first day of December next, so as to leave the said street of the full width, as shown on the Plan of said street, on file in the office of the City Clerk."

Oct. 26, 1859. "The returns of service of the several Orders in relation to the grading of Watson Street, and the sidewalks on Cambridge Street, and the removal of encroachments upon Magazine and Harvard Streets, were received and placed on file."

Dec. 7, 1859. Ordered by the Board, as Surveyors of Highways, that the Superintendent of Streets be authorized and instructed to cause all obstructions, except buildings, in Magazine and Harvard Streets, to be removed within three weeks from the date of this Order."

Dec. 14, 1859. "The vote whereby the Order in relation to the removal of obstructions on Magazine and Harvard Streets was adopted at the last meeting was reconsidered, and the Order was amended so as to read as follows:-

Ordered, that the Superintendent of Streets be authorized and

instructed to cause all obstructions in Magazine and
Howard Streets to be removed before the first day of
June next.

As announced, the Order was adopted.

May 9, 1864. - The matter of the encroachments upon Concord
Avenue, Howard Street and Magazine Street, was considered
and, in view of the lateness of the season, it was
Ordered, That the Superintendent of Streets be authorized
to suspend further action in relation to removing said en-
croachments, until otherwise ordered.
