IN BOARD OF MAYOR AND ALDERMEN, }
July 27, 1870. }

WHEREAS, in the opinion of the Board, the safety and convenience of the inhabitants require that Highland Street, so called, from Appleton Street to Reservoir Street, should be laid out as a public way:

It is therefore hereby

ORDERED, That due notice be given to the abutters on said Highland Street and all other persons interested, that this Board intends to lay out the street before mentioned, by taking a portion of their land and laying out the same as a Public Street — and also that due notice be given to all persons and parties owning or having any rights in estates that will be benefitted by the said proposed laying out of said Street, that this Board intends to assess a portion of the expense thereof upon the estates so benefitted according to law—and that

WEDNESDAY,

o'clock, P. M.,

is assigned as the time for hearing any objections which may be made thereto.

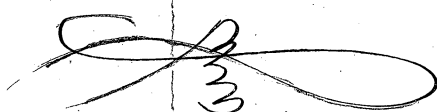

In Board of Aldermen, Dec 21st 1870

Whereas:

It is adjudged by this Board that the public necessity and convenience require that Highland Street so called from Appleton to Reservoir Street be laid out as a public way.

Ordered: That said Highland Street be and hereby is laid out and established as a public way, by the name of Highland Street, agreeably to a plan thereof drawn by the City Engineer bearing date of December 21st 1870, and now before this Board, to wit from Appleton Street to Reservoir Street, the same to be forty feet in width as shown by the red lines delineated on said plan.

Ordered, That no damages be awarded to the persons over whose land said Highland^{Street} is laid out as aforesaid.
