Stride Rite Corporation, whose national reputation as a progressive company results from such initiatives as a work-study scholarship program and innovative child care centers, recently announced a comprehensive clear indoor air policy at its Cambridge Center headquarters; and

WHEREAS:

Stride Rite's new policy bans smoking at its Cambridge workplace for all 450 employees, allowing smoking only in one closed room off the cafeteria; and

WHEREAS:

The new policy was developed in consultation with employees, among whom it has found widespread support; therefore, be it

RESOLVED:

That the Cambridge City Council commend Stride Rite Corporation for its pathbreaking anti-smoking policy; and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Council urge other Cambridge employers and employees to consider similar policies; and be it further

RESOLVED:

That the City Clerk send a copy of this resolution to Stride Rite Corporation on behalf of the entire City Council.

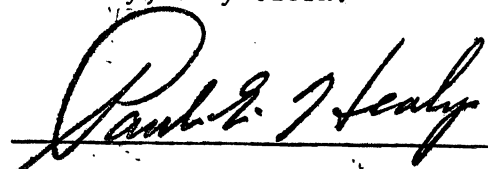
