WHEREAS: The closing of Sancta Maria Hospital as an acute medical care facility and the recent announcement that Choate-Symmes Hospital in Arlington will be closing have regional implications for the delivery of acute health care services and intensify the sense of urgency which prompted me to sponsor my City Council Order of December 19, 1988, adopted by this City Council requesting that the City Manager explore the ramifications of regional ownership of The Cambridge Hospital and report back to the City Council relative thereto due to the fact that as of this date no report has been forthcoming; now therefore be it

ORDERED: That the City Manager be and hereby is requested to provide a status update on this matter to the City Council by October 30, 1989, followed by a final report for City Council examination, discussion and response no later than November 20, 1989.
