Petition of Metropolitan Transit Authority for approval by the Department of the erection, maintenance and use of poles to support the wires of its electrical system.

Appearance: W. Fitzsimons, Esq., for the Petitioner

This is a petition of the Metropolitan Transit Authority under the provisions of section 10 of Chapter 544 of the Acts of 1947 for a determination that public interest requires the granting of permission to erect, maintain and use a pole to support the wires of its electrical system on Massachusetts Avenue in the city of Cambridge.

This location is required to enable the Metropolitan Transit Authority to relocate a pole presently installed in the sidewalk and supporting the wires of its trackless trolley system. It is necessitated by highway construction in connection with a street widening in the area. The specific location was designated by the Massachusetts Department of Public Works.

After notice, consideration and a public hearing held on May 12, 1961 at the State House at which time no one appeared in opposition, it is

ORDERED: That the Metropolitan Transit Authority be and hereby is granted permission to erect, maintain and use one pole to support the wires of its electrical system in the city of Cambridge as follows:

One (1) pole on the westerly side of Massachusetts Avenue,
in a traffic island, situated between Jarvis and Everett
streets

all substantially as shown on a Metropolitan Transit Authority plan on file with
the Department numbered #C-15441 dated November 2, 1960 and further identified
as Exhibit I.

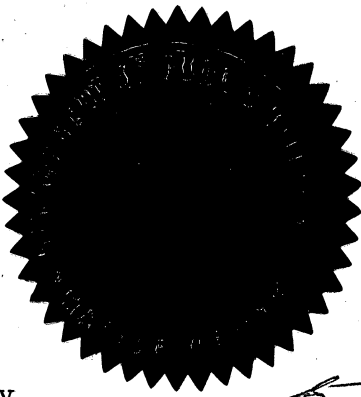
Also permission be and hereby is granted to said Metropolitan
Transit Authority to attach its wires, fixtures and related apparatus to said pole
and to make underground and surface alterations to the street necessary for that
purpose, all in accordance with the testimony at the hearing, the Department

DETERMINES the above grant of location to be in the
public interest.

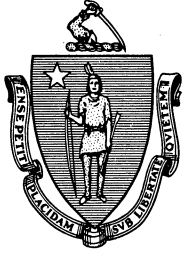

APPEAL CLAUSE

AN APPEAL AS TO MATTERS OF LAW FROM ANY FINAL DECISION, ORDER OR RULING OF THE COMMISSION MAY BE TAKEN TO THE SUPREME JUDICIAL COURT BY AN AGGRIEVED PARTY IN INTEREST BY THE FILING OF A WRITTEN PETITION PRAYING THAT THE ORDER OF THE COMMISSION BE MODIFIED OR SET ASIDE IN WHOLE OR IN PART.

SUCH PETITION FOR APPEAL SHALL BE FILED WITH THE SECRETARY OF THE COMMISSION WITHIN TWENTY DAYS AFTER THE DATE OF THE DECISION, ORDER OR RULING OF THE COMMISSION, OR WITHIN SUCH FURTHER TIME AS THE COMMISSION MAY ALLOW UPON REQUEST FILED PRIOR TO THE EXPIRATION OF TWENTY DAYS AFTER THE DECISION, ORDER OR RULING. (SEC. 5, CHAP. 25, G.L., TER. ED.)
