To the Honorable City Council of the City of Cambridge,

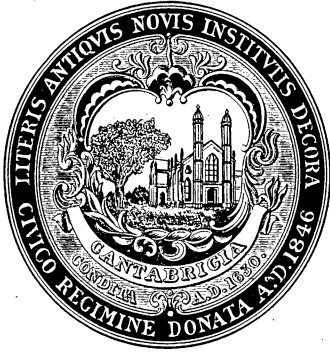
Gentlemen:-
