I have talked to officials of the MDC and the Electronics Corporation of America concerning the 7 AM to 10 AM parking restriction on all their roads in the City of Cambridge. I have informed the MDC that the EPA regulations allow for residents of the City to park during those hours and they will honor our Resident Parking Permits.

As for the Electronics Corporation of America, they have leased parking spaces in the vicinity of their place of business but they are concerned with their visitors and salespeople.

I have informed them as well as the MDC that under the EPA laws, one hour parking meters can be installed in these areas.

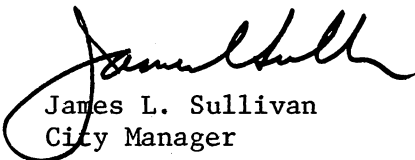
