Attached is an order requesting the appropriation of a grant fund for \$18,267.00 from the Massachusetts' Department of Education to the Human Service salary & wages account \$11,266.00, other ordinary maintenance \$6,601.00 account and travel & training account \$400.00 to provide funds for ABE, ESL and GED tutoring services to 20 families living in transitional shelters in Cambridge. It is a collaborative project among the Learning Center, Planning and Development Division, and four family shelters sponsored by the YMCA and St. Paul's AME Church. Participants will be transitioned into on-going classes at the Community Learning Center.
