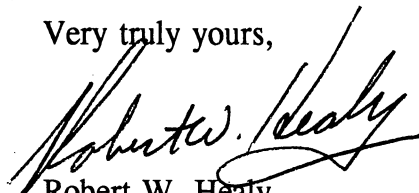

To The Honorable, The City Council:

I am hereby requesting your review and acceptance of an appropriation for \$615,663.27 (\$114,000.00 from the Harvard Square Improvement Fund and \$501,663.27 from Harvard University) to the Community Development Public Investment Extraordinary Expenditures Account.

As detailed in the Final Report of the Quincy Square Park Project Committee, the City plans to construct a park at the intersection of Harvard Street and Massachusetts Avenue once the sewer separation project is completed later this summer. A final design plan will be drawn up in the next four weeks, following the preferred scheme produced for the Committee in its earlier deliberations.
