- WHEREAS: This City Council was deeply saddened upon learning of the death of retired Superintendent of Schools Frank Frisoli; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Frisoli, a lifelong Cambridge resident, attended local schools, graduating from Cambridge High and Latin School and Harvard College, as well as from Boston University where he obtained a Master of Arts degree; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Frisoli, a veteran teacher and administrator, began his career within the Cambridge Public School System in 1938 assigned as a Foreign Language Teacher at the former Putnam School and he continued to hold various teaching assignments until 1952 at which time he was appointed Assistant Headmaster of Cambridge High and Latin School; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Frisoli, a dedicated and experienced administrator, was appointed Assistant Superintendent of Schools in 1969, Acting Superintendent in 1970 and Superintendent in 1971, remaining in that position until 1973; and
- WHEREAS: Mr. Frisoli provided assistance and leadership to the students and faculty throughout his long public service career, always making himself available to provide guidance and friendship whenever possible; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That this City Council go on record extending its deepest sympathy to Mrs. Mary Frisoli and the entire family at this time of such personal loss; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That the City Clerk be and hereby is requested to forward a suitably engrossed copy of this resolution to Mrs. Frisoli on behalf of the entire City Council.
