Gentlemen:

In a report of the City Engineer dated Sept. 4, 1916, the construction of certain sewers were reported with schedules of assessments to be levied including one for the construction of a sewer in Scott St. from Holden St. to Beacon St. This was an error, as the construction and assessment had been reported in 1915.
