Cambridge, April 15 1884

To the Honorable, the Mayor, and Aldermen,
of the City of Cambridge,

The undersigned ~~respectfully pray~~ being interested in wharf property on Charles River and in the navigation thereof and having been informed that extensive repairs are proposed on the draws of some of the bridges on the River would respectfully represent that the draws as now constructed are not of sufficient width to admit the passage through them of such class of vessels as are required and now in use for the transportation of Coal Lumber and other heavy Merchandise and that it is desirable that the width of these draws shall be made to conform to those of the West Boston and other bridges below it and believing that the widening at this time the expense would be less than at any future time by at least the cost of the anticipated repairs We respectfully pray that such action be now taken by Conference with the City of Boston and otherwise as shall insure the widening of said draws to a uniform width to compare with those of the bridges below (36 ft-)
