This transfer is necessary in order that we may be able to meet our obligations for the payment of medical services rendered to members of this department.

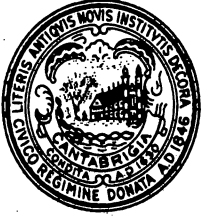


