The Metropolitan District Commission will give an adjourned hearing at the offices of the Commission, 1 Ashburton Place, Boston, on Wednesday, October 14, at 10 A.M., under Chapter 16 of the Resolves of 1925, on the question of an additional main sewer from the present Metropolitan Sewer in Woburn, through the city of Woburn to the Woburn-Wilmington line near the works of the American Agricultural Chemical Company, and on whether any part of the cost of the sewer shall be borne by the North Metropolitan Sewerage District, and, if so, what part, and how the cost shall be apportioned.

The Commission will be glad to receive a brief or written argument on these questions from those interested therein on or before October 14.

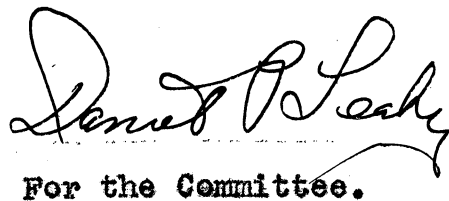
