MAYOR VELLUCCI

- WHEREAS: The Ikego Forest, a green space and wildlife preserve of some 700 acres near the city of Zushi in Japan, is one of the significant natural parks left in the Tokyo metropolitan area; and
- WHEREAS: The U.S. Navy plans to take over and bulldoze a good part of Ikego Forest for housing for naval personnel from nearby bases, thereby irreparably damaging the area as a whole; and
- WHEREAS: The people of Zushi have expressed their desire to preserve Ikego Forest in its natural state as a public park and reservation, electing their present Mayor Kiichiro Tomino on a platform of conservation; now therefore be it
- RESOLVED: That the Cambridge City Council looks with favor on the efforts of the citizens of Zushi to preserve their natural heritage and calls upon the U.S. government to respect the desire of the people of Zushi to keep Ikego Forest intact and unmolested; and be it further
- RESOLVED: That copies of this resolution be sent to the U.S. Secretary of Defense Carlucci, to President Reagan, and Senators Kennedy and Kerry.
