Subject Special Speed Regulation #7491 For Fayerweather Street

I have reviewed the attached Special Speed Regulation for Fayerweather Street from the Massachusetts Department of Public Works and it is in line with our request to lower the speed limit in both directions on Fayerweather Street to 25 M.P.H.

The regulation should be approved by the City Council and returned to the MDPW. Upon receipt of the approved regulation we will install the required signs and notify the Cambridge Police when they are posted.

In accordance with the provisions of Chapter 90, Section, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.) as amended, the following Special Speed Regulation is

hereby Adopted
by the City Council
of the City of Cambridge

That the following speed limits are established at which motor vehicles may be operated in the areas described:

FAYERWEATHER STREET - NORTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Brattle Street
Thence northerly

0.31 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the end of northbound travel of Fayerweather Street (the junction of Huron Avenue); the total distance being 0.31 miles.

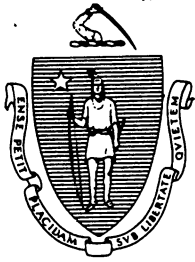
FAYERWEATHER STREET - SOUTHBOUND

Beginning at the junction of Walden Street
Thence southerly

0.74 miles at 25 miles per hour ending at the junction of Brattle Street; the total distance being 0.74 miles.

Operation of a motor vehicle at a rate of speed in excess of these limits shall be prima facie evidence that such speed is greater than is reasonable and proper.

The provisions of this regulation shall not, however, abrogate in any sense Chapter 90, Section 14, of the General Laws (Ter. Ed.).
