Owned Cambridge steak house

Socrates Touloupoulos of Arlington, proprietor since 1966 of the Newtowne Grill & Steak House in Porter Square, Cambridge, died of a stroke yesterday in Symmes Hospital, Arlington. He was 75.

He also owned the Mystic Diner of Somerville, which was torn down in 1966, after three decades, to make way for an extension of Route 93.

Born in Kozanis, Greece, Mr. Touloupoulos came to the United States as a young man. He was a member of the Moses Michael Hayes Masonic Lodge in Needham, the Lions Club of Somerville and the Pan-Macedonian Association of New England.

He leaves his wife, Elizabeth (Kehayias); two sons, William of Arlington and Nicholas of Woburn; a daughter, Mary Koskores of North Andover; a brother, John of Arlington; a sister, Evdozia Mantzoukas of Somerville; and nine grandchildren.

Services will be held at 11 a.m. Thursday in the Greek Orthodox Church, Arlington.
