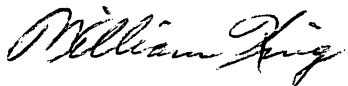
Gentlemen:

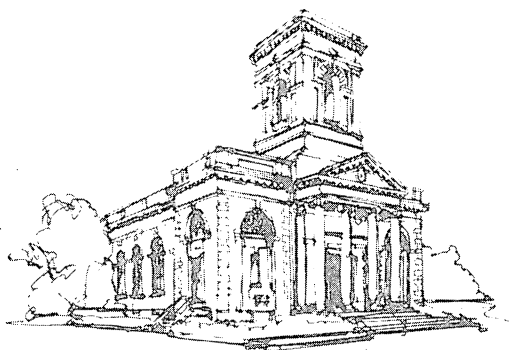
