IN CITY COUNCIL

May 9, 1977

ORDERED:

That, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance relative to placing and maintaining signs, the Commissioner of Public Works be and hereby is authorized to grant a permit to San Taha for the erection of a sign at 1312 Massachusetts Avenue, Cambridge.

Provided that, before erecting the above named sign, the petitioner shall obtain a permit from the Building Department and file with the City Clerk a satisfactory bond in the sum of Two Thousand Dollars (\$2,000.00) conditioned to save harmless the City of Cambridge from all claims for damages arising from the construction, maintenance and use of said sign.

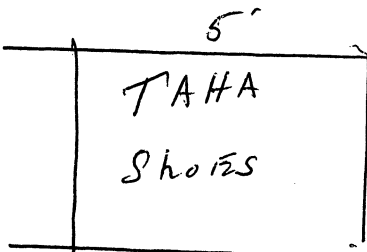

SECTION 1412.0 STATE BUILDING CODE

2. All signs must meet requirements of Zoning Ordinances and Building Code.
