In regard to FY'95 Public Investment Projects for Open Space, commitments have been made for the renovation of the Library Park Tot Lot and for the establishment of the preventative maintenance program for tot lot equipment. During the FY'96 Public Investment Budget process, the Open Space committee will review the Glacken Field Tennis Courts and will make recommendations regarding the scope of work required, related costs and the order of priority based on other renovation needs established by the City's inventory of open space and the preventative maintenance program.

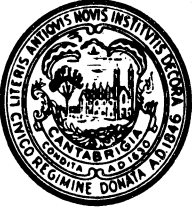

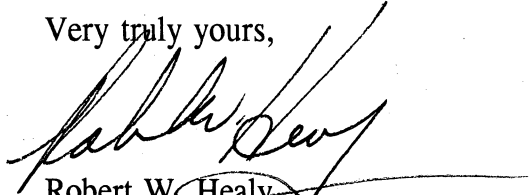
