WHEREAS: The access of Cambridge residents to the various departments and commissions of their City government is of the greatest importance; and

WHEREAS: Every effort possible must be made to avoid impeding the public's access to City departments; and

WHEREAS: Complaints have been received regarding the unavailability of new department telephone numbers, some of which are apparently not listed with the telephone information service; and

WHEREAS: Although new numbers are published yearly in the local press, it has been requested that these telephone numbers be published more than once a year; now therefore be it

RESOLVED: That the City Council request the City Manager to look into the matter of publishing City of Cambridge government telephone listings twice yearly in the local press, and further ensure that the local telephone information service has all current City listings, and report back within one week.
