CAMBRIDGE, MASS.

Last night at 7:30 p.m., a meeting of Cambridge residents took place at the Blessed Sacrement School. The following resolutions are the results of this meeting.-

1. The property at 160 -- 166½ Pearl Street, abutting the fire site, and the property at 21 Valentine Street are owned by Mr. Ted Lane of Triple A. Plastics and are being used for industrial warehousing in violation of the zoning law. We want ALL the stored materials on these properties removed immediately and within a definite time limit.
2. Last week, the residents in this area were physically, emotionally and financially inconvenienced - We don't, and we're sure you don't wish anyone, anywhere to go through the same frightening experience. If this material is being stored elsewhere in the city of Cambridge, we want to know that it is in accordance with the fire and zoning laws.
3. The Department of Building Inspectors was notified of the zoning violation more than once. As residents and tax payers of the city of Cambridge, we not only expect representation and protection from our elected officials, as well as our appointed officials, but we are entitled to it. We shouldn't have to assemble as we are to demand our rights. In view of this and the circumstances, we believe we are entitled to an explanation.
4. It was necessary for the Fire Department to engage the services

of the Duane Wrecking Company to assist in putting out the fire at Triple A. Plastics and equally important, for the safety of everyone, to remove the charred ruins. However, since this fire has already cost the City of Cambridge far more than it should, we don't believe we should be financially responsible for the removal of the debris from the fire site. Perhaps the fire was unavoidable but if the laws had been enforced and obeyed, the cost and time involved to put out the fire would have been much less.

The residents will be meeting again on Thursday, January 25, 1973 at 7:30 p.m. at the Blessed Sacrement School, Corporal McTernan Street, Cambridge. We extend invitations to: Mayor Barbara Ackerman; City Manager, Mr. John Corcoran; Building Inspectors, Mr. Sprague and Mr. Vincent Kelley; and City Councilors, Mr. Daniel Clinton; Mr. Walter Sullivan; Mr. Alfred Vellucci; Mr. Henry Owens; Mr. Thomas Danehy; Mr. Robert Moncreiff; Mr. Francis Duehay and Ms. Sandra Graham.
