To the Honorable, the City Council:

At the November 16th City Council meeting I placed on my agenda an order requesting the transfer of \$10,000 within the Rent Control Department to provide funds for medical related expenses of a worker's compensation claim. Councillor Walsh exercised his charter right on this order and requested information on the nature of the claim.

In January 1992, an employee of the Rent Control Department sustained a back injury (a herniated disk) while attempting to open the (stuck) bottom drawer of a filing cabinet. The injury required back surgery, and the individual is now receiving physical therapy. The breakdown of the fees is as follows:

Physician fees:	\$1,657.13
Ortho Clinic:	\$ 175.49
New England Baptist Hospital:	\$7,892.35
Physical therapy:	\$ 250.00
