

RESOLUTION I

WHEREAS, Question 2, Proposition 2¹/₂, on the State Election Ballot being considered by the voters in the Commonwealth of Massachusetts on November 4, 1980 will do great harm to the 351 cities and towns of the state, if passed and

WHEREAS, passage and implementation of said question would prevent clerks from carrying out their state mandated functions, and further

WHEREAS, passage and implementation would disrupt even the minimum of service required locally accross the state such as recording births, deaths and marriages as well as registering voters and running elections, not to mention issuing licenses, recording chattel mortgages, recording town meeting action, etc.
