In reference to City Council Order of Dec. 20, 1954, to increase the size of street lights at Tremont & Carlisle Sts., please be advised that the light at this section is the standard size for secondary streets.

Upon investigation of this area, I find a very dark spot on Tremont St. between Hampshire & Carlisle Sts., and I would recommend installing 1-2500 lumen light on the first pole on Tremont St. in from Hampshire St., which I believe will answer the purpose to a greater advantage.


