COUNCILLOR SULLIVAN

WHEREAS: This City Council held a public hearing on Monday, November 13, 1978 to discuss the petition of the Bioran Medical Laboratory for the operation of a refuse disposal facility at the premises numbered 9 Columbia Street, Cambridge; and

WHEREAS: At said public hearing, the City Council was informed that as a result of a public hearing held on November 6, 1978 under the provisions of Chapter 111, Section 150A of the Massachusetts General Laws by Robert W. Healy, Assistant City Manager, that at said hearing the petition of Bioran Medical Laboratory for assignment of 9 Columbia Street as a site of a refuse disposal facility, that is an incinerator as approved by the Department of Environmental Quality Engineering of the Commonwealth of Massachusetts, said petition of Bioran Medical Laboratory was approved subject to the following conditions:

1. That the stack height be reduced from 52 feet to 26 feet in response to the objections of the parish;
2. That in addition to inspectors from the Department of Public Health, Inspectors from the City of Cambridge Health Department may recommend rescission of assignment of the site upon a determination that the incinerator is being operated in a manner that results in a nuisance or danger to public health;

therefore be it

ORDERED: That this City Council does hereby record its approval of the petition of Bioran Medical Laboratory for assignment of 9 Columbia Street as a site for a refuse disposal facility subject to the conditions outlined above and promulgated after the public hearing held by the Assistant City Manager on Wednesday, September 6, 1978.
