The expense thereof to be charged to the appropriation for Street Department: Paving (Edgestones and Sidewalks). The cost of materials furnished to be assessed upon the owners of abutting estates according to law.

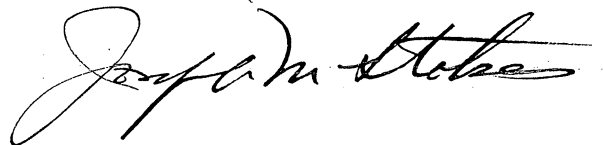
