



To the Honorable, the City Council:

The attached appropriation order of \$12,536.00 is to cover the cost of the police officer's salary assigned to the administration of Police Details, to provide for the service charges attached to the processing of the detail checks by the bank, and to reimburse the General Fund for payments to police officers on detail assignments. These particular payments, of \$6,636.00 were not collected from the company requesting the detail because of bankruptcy. It is expected that as a result of bankruptcy proceedings the Detail Fund will be reimbursed twenty cents on the dollar.

Passage of this order is recommended.
