RESOLVED: That all residents of Cambridge are encouraged to take part in the exciting festivities which have been planned throughout **DANCE MONTH**.

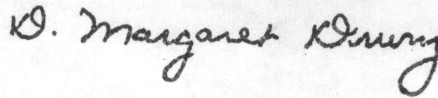
