WHEREAS: It has come to the attention of the City Council that Friends of Alewife is the recipient of a 2004 Local Cultural Council Grant; and

WHEREAS: The grant will provide support for teens from Cambridge Rindge and Latin who will work with veteran muralist, David Fichter, to paint and install a mural depicting the environment of the Alewife Reservation area. The 80 foot long mural will be installed at the Alewife subway station; and

WHEREAS: This exciting artistic project with real community focus will enrich the Cambridge Community; now therefore be it
